Relaxing at the **Parish Quay**

There was probably a hard or quay at Botley in the medieval period and it was a significant river port during the 18th and 19th centuries. Records in the early 19th century show that there were substantial timber yards and wharves here as well as a bark store and a shed where mast hoops were steamed and bent.
