
Questionnaire February 2016





Eastleigh Borough Council and Hampshire County Council are pushing ahead with plans for 375 houses at the back of Winchester Street and for a by-pass.

A Neighbourhood Plan

A Neighbourhood Plan is being put together, which will have statutory powers, to reflect the views and concerns of the residents of Botley. It is an important document and your opportunity to shape the future of our Parish - the houses and roads that are built and the infrastructure required to support it.





If you do what are the obstacles now and the opportunities for the future

HOW CAN WE MAKE BOTLEY A PLACE WHERE PEOPLE WANT TO COME TO SHOP AND TO RELAX

The Botley Neighbourhood Plan Committee is actively preparing a Neighbourhood Plan, which will help to protect what is good about Botley. A couple of years ago we surveyed most businesses in Botley in preparation of this Plan. Responses said that parking, for customers and staff, was an issue. Also, you also said that the local environment needed improving – litter, appearance of the streets, lighting for example. Furthermore, you said that you would like to be kept informed about developments. We have noted the views we were given and will take these on board, but we really would like to know more about other ideas you might have. We know many local businesses find the current economic climate challenging. We are hoping to have the first draft of our policies ready for consultation by autumn this year, and then you will have a chance to comment on them.

Botley is changing. There will be a lot of new housing built. With the by-pass opening in the next few years we will want to alter the design of the High Street and want your views on this. We need Botley to be a place where people want to come to because it is interesting, accessible and attractive. Working together we can make Botley a good place in which to live, to visit, to work and to play.

The bypass allows the possibility of

- downgrade existing A334 to B road status;
- major reduction in traffic through Botley Village;
- significantly reduces air pollution in the village centre;
- removal of wide load route designation;

Some ideas and suggestions are listed below to change the Square and the A334 through Botley all with the objective of <u>Making Botley a Destination</u> and increasing <u>trading opportunities</u>

We would appreciate any comments on these. There is also space for further ideas or suggestions

Increase parking in the Square by:

- 1. Use existing bus stops and delivery locations for parking these become mobile traffic barriers deterring through traffic;
- 2. Major re-layout of the Square to give either:
 - a. more parking spaces, for example echelon parking;
 - b. more community/pedestrian/seating area;
 - c. both of the above;
- 3. Do we need the existing light-controlled traffic lights opposite the Market Hall;
- 4. Change day-time parking time to a new time please suggest your limit.

Better Integration of the Mill shopping complex:

- 1. Widen footpath from the Square to the Mill this would also facilitate Mill Hill as a priority traffic scheme and add to deterrence of through route usage;
- 2. Pedestrian crossing at bottom of Winchester Street.

Other items:

- 1. Cycle ways along the entire length of what is now the A334 through the Village centre;
- 2. Pedestrian crossing at entrance near the High Street Recreation Ground;
- 3. More closures of the Square for community activities.

Other ideas and suggestions:

- 1. Amend Maypole roundabout to narrow entrance to Botley;
- 2. Selectively widen footpath on A334;
- 3. Your ideas and suggestions, please continue overleaf if required.
